

High School Cafeteria Policies

Free/reduced lunch status from last school year remains in effect for the first month of the school year in August only. Every year new forms need to be filled out and returned immediately for processing. These forms have to be turned in every new school year whether or not the information is changed from the last time you submitted them. We cannot assume this information, Note: It is very important to return completed forms in by the first day of school. If not, your child's lunch account will be charged regular prices and may not be pro-rated back if you qualify for these benefits.

Students who pay for meals must have money each day. Parents may pre-pay weekly by check for their child's meals in their lunch account or through Ed-line with Café Enterprise. Students that reach the charge limit will receive a statement. In many cases, there will be a follow up phone call. We want to avoid this if possible. You can always call the cafeteria regarding your child's account. M-F -7:00a.m.-2:00 p.m. 233-5648

***Students that have reached the charge limit will be provided an alternate lunch. This includes a peanut butter or cheese sandwich with a milk or juice.

***Parents please understand and act on this charge policy. This can be very uncomfortable for the cafeteria staff and your child.

Breakfast Prices: Regular \$1.25—reduced .30c—Guest \$1.50 Staff--\$1.50

Lunch Prices : Regular \$2.00—Reduced .40c ---Guest \$3.00 Staff \$2.50 Milk/Juice....50c ***extra also .50c extra lunch entrée \$1.50

A La Carte's: Variety of snacks, bottled waters, Gatorades are additional. Prices vary from .25c to \$1.25.

Free/Reduced students cannot charge these items unless there is money in their accounts or they have money in hand to purchase as for regular students.

Condiments: Ketchup after 5 packs, extra 5c each. Extra Sauces & dips 25c ea.

Cafeteria Rules: NO GUM!

- Enter the cafeteria walking in a line. No running or jumping.
- At breakfast and lunch each student punches in his/her pin number. Then, presses "Enter" after receiving their meals and going through the serving line.
- Get everything you need as you go through the serving line.
- Stay at you seat unless you are permitted to exit by staff or teacher, or monitor.
- Raise your hand if you need help.
- Keep your hands, feet, utensils and food to yourself. Do not play or tamper with other student's food at the table or in the serving line.
- Please help keep the cafeteria clean. Picking up all trash, etc.
- Use good manners in all areas of the cafeteria.
- Students who break cafeteria rules will be issued a note from the cafeteria manager to the principal and teacher. This note will be followed by the consequences for disrespect as in the other school rules for discipline.
